



Welcome to Your New RNA Website

The development team of the rochesternumismaticassociation.org website would like to welcome you to an exciting new tool reflecting the best the RNA has to offer. Below is an overview of each section so you can begin to see information about your club some of which has never before available to you.

First, this website is available to anyone around the world that has web access. However, members of the RNA, in good standing, can access topics the general public cannot access. These menu items are denoted with a +. ***Note – you must be logged in to access the members only information.***

Home Page:

You will be greeted by the charter members of our club from 1912 and the presidents who attended our 100th anniversary celebration in 2012. You can click on any name and a popup window will show their medal. Presidential medals have been struck for every president since Dr. George French, the first president of the RNA. This page is where you will login to see members-only content. Once logged in you will see, above the LOGOUT button, your dues status. Please heed this message and pay your dues if they are in arrears. Highlights and our purpose are also available on the home page. Across the top of the page is the access menu for the rest of the website. This menu is available wherever you navigate on the website. At the bottom of each page, you can click on Join RNA to access the membership application.

About Us:

On the left are the names of the RNA Board of Directors. The current president's name is highlighted and will allow you to send an email to him or her if you have any questions about the club. The president will answer or redirect your message to someone who will. The balance of the page highlights membership, the Rochester Junior Numismatic Association (click on flyer link to see more information) and our meetings.

Calendar:

This page covers everything about our meetings, including the calendar going forward several months, where and when we meet and the topics of our meetings. These meetings are open to anyone with an interest in coin collecting, currency and medal collecting. Each meeting is an education in these collecting areas.

Archives:

Here you will find information covering our newsletters for the past decade; earlier newsletters will be added as they become available. The archives are open to anyone and is a goldmine of information with articles written by our members. RNA minutes and official documents are only available to members in good standing. To access this information, simply move the cursor over the menu and a dropdown will appear so you can select the topic you are interested in.

Collections:

As mentioned earlier, the RNA strikes medals for each president and they are all available here along with the many non-presidential medals such as anniversary medals. On the right side of the page is a list, by decade, if you want to focus on a particular timeframe. You may also view the reverse of every medal by clicking on the REV button. These medals are all available to the public. The club's collection is only available to members and is one of the finest collections anywhere. It is a great research tool which allows you to filter on areas of interest such as U.S. Large Cents, Ancient Coins or China, etc.

Store:

This is where you can pay your dues, pay for the annual picnic and banquet, pay for your postage to have your annual presidential delivered or donate to the club. Other options will be added as they become available.

All payments are via a secure service called PayPal. Most people are aware of PayPal and many of us use it regularly to pay for online purchases. PayPal is a secure website and you can use it in one of two ways. If you have a PayPal account, you can use it to pay. If you do not have a PayPal account, you can pay as a guest using a debit or credit card.

There are three types of donations:

1. Unrestricted – can be used for anything that benefits the club.
2. Restricted – can only be used as you request.
3. Endowment – will become part of the RNA endowment fund, managed by the Rochester Area Community Foundation (RACF).
